Arthur James Rosler, age 87, of Alliance, died at 6:50 p.m. Monday, October 15, 2012 at McCrea Manor. He was born August 14, 1925 in Alliance, Ohio to John and Regina (Richter) Rosler. Arthur joined the U. S. Navy when he was 17, where he finished his high school diploma. From 1943-1946, as a Navy Gunner, he spent 20 months in the North Atlantic, Scotland, England, and France He also spent nine months in the Pacific; in Pearl Harbor, Manila, Samar, Guam, Saigon, Taiwan, and Yokohama, Japan. After WWII, Arthur worked at Alliance Printing, the Alliance Review, and the Canton Repository as a compositor. He later retired from Babcock and Wilcox Tubular Products Division, after 38 years of service. Mr. Rosler played and coached Hot Stove Little League was a life member of the VFW, avid Mt. Union Purple Raiders, Alliance Aviators, and Ohio State Sports fan.
