Charles Baird "Spike" Johnson, 89, of Alliance died Monday, March 29, 2004 at 10:10 a.m. He was born on May 13, 1914 in Minerva and had lived most of his life in Alliance. A graduate of Alliance High School, he attended Mount Union College and was a member of the Sigma Nu Fraternity. He was the owner of Robertson Supply Company for 54 years and was a member of the First United Presbyterian Church.
