Clyde J. Maloney, age 92, of Alliance, passed away at 11:07 a.m. Monday, July 12, 2010. He was born, March 27, 1918, in Alliance, Ohio, to William and Ruth (Hill) Maloney. A graduate of Alliance High School, Clyde retired from Transue and Williams Company in 1981 with forty years of service. Upon retiring, he was well known for building handmade doll houses for families in the Alliance area and across the country. Clyde was a member of the First Christian Church and was a former deacon at the church. He was a life member of the American Legion Post No. 166 in Alliance. He enjoyed camping with his family, and was an avid Cleveland Indians fan. Clyde was a United States Army Veteran having served during World War II in Central Europe. He was the recipient of five Bronze Stars. Survivors include his five daughters, Joanne (John) Brick of Winterville, N.C., Jean Patterson and Karen Custar, both of Alliance, Sally (Jim) Green of Duluth, Georgia, and Sue (Mark) Herndon of Carmel, Indiana; 16 grandchildren; 25 great-grandchildren; sister, Edith Burger of Chino Valley, Arizona; and many nieces and nephews.
