Ernest L. Kolm, 74, of Alliance, died on Tuesday, June 13, 2006 at 4:20 a.m. at Crandall Medical Center. Born in Canton on August 31, 1931, he lived most of his life in the Alliance and Louisville areas. He graduated from Louisville High School and attended Akron and Youngstown Universities.
