



## Evalyn P. Page

May 10, 1916 - July 29, 2002

Evalyn P. Page, 86, of Boardman, died on Monday, July 29, 2002 at 1:40 a.m. at St. Elizabeth Hospital. Born in Fawn Grove, PA, on May 10, 1916, she had recently moved to Boardman from Port Charlotte, FL where she resided for the past 14 years at South Port Square. A graduate of Lititz High School in PA, she attended Gettysburg College. She married Evangelist Rev. G. Gordon Parker on June 18, 1936, ministering with him in Liberia, W. Africa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, Collinsville, Conn., and in British Guyana, S. America. She was a volunteer at Medical Center Hospital in Port Charlotte and a member of the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd in Punta Gorda, FL. Survivors include two daughters and sons-in-law; Evangeline (Parker) and Rev. James McDorman of Boardman, and Judith (Parker) and David Hornischer of Fremont, Nebraska; five grandchildren, William Wilkey III, Julie Bechtel, Amy Bossong, Kathleen Menegay and Alan McDorman; six great-grandchildren, two step great-grandchildren; four great-great-granddaughters; and a sister, Kathryn Mummert. Preceding her in death were her first husband, Rev. G. Gordon Parker on June 26, 1967; her second husband, Rev. Kenneth Page on December 1, 1980; her parents, David Amm and Clara May (Shaffer) Zimmerman; and a brother Winston G. Parker who was killed in Vietnam on My 9, 1968. Memorial services will be held at a later date. Burial will take place in W. Gill Cemetery in Gill, MA following cremation.
