January 1, 1921 - July 3, 2003

Harold Leonard Woolf, 81, of Alliance, died Thursday, July 3, 2003, at 6:48 p.m. at Alliance Community Hospital. Born in Sebring Aug. 30, 1921, he had lived most of his life in the Alliance area. A veteran of the U.S. Navy during World War II, he served with the Naval Reserves during the Korean conflict. He was an insurance agent for Equitable Life Insurance Company, a member of Beechwood Christian Church, and thoroughly loved music.
