Linda Webb (Lembright) Bandy, 74, of Homeworth, died peacefully due to complications from Multiple Sclerosis on Sunday, April 16, 2017, at Crandall Medical Center.

She was born August 28, 1942, in Clarksburg, West Virginia, to Dr. Joseph Frederick and Audra (Webb) Lembright. Linda was a 1960 graduate of Alliance High School and attended Miami University and Bliss Business School in Columbus.

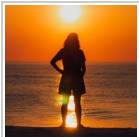
