Lois Jane Peters, age 88, of Alliance, passed away at 11:04 p.m. Saturday, December 4, 2010 at Alliance Community Hospital. She was born December 17, 1921 in Akron, Ohio to James F. and Leona (Acker) Appleby. Mrs. Peters was an active lifetime member of Christ United Methodist Church. In her youth, she taught dancing at Jeannie Reisch Dance Studios, and later, in her golden years, took up tap dancing, taught by Sis Cassidy. Being an only child, Lois Jane lovingly embraced her husband's large family of six boys and one girl and many of her activities involved them. A housewife, she enjoyed all that came with raising two boys and one girl; after her children were almost grown, she worked at the front counter at Manhattan Dry Cleaners. She also stayed connected to girlfriends of her high school days, with what they called their monthly "Club" for 70 years. Lois Jane played golf for a number of years and enjoyed watching sports, including the Buckeyes, Browns; and she was a die hard Indians fan.
