



## Luther Elroy Dutrow

August 19, 1927 - March 10, 2006

Luther Elroy Dutrow, Jr., 78, of Alliance, died on Friday, March 10, 2006 at 2:18 p.m. at Alliance Community Hospital. Mr. Dutrow was born in Alliance on August 19, 1927 and lived in Alliance all his life. A graduate of Alliance High School, he served in the US Army from 1946 to 1947, which included time in Japan with the occupation forces. He retired from Aultman Hospital after 25 years of service as a cabinetmaker and was also previously employed as a custodian for the Marlinton School District. Mr. Dutrow was a member of the Beechwood United Methodist Church and served as a trustee, Beechwood Pioneers, Washington Twp. Historical Society and was a former member of the Washington Ruritan Club. Luther spent hours on the telephone talking to friends and spent time on the computer. He enjoyed woodworking and helping people. Survivors include his wife, Lois (Carson) Dutrow, (whom he married September 25, 1949); a son, David L. (Allyson) Dutrow of Mansfield; a daughter, Nancy L.
