May 27, 1920 - January 28, 2006

Martha Eileen Snyder, age 85, passed away on January 21, 2006 at 6:50 p.m., after a long and courageous 15 year battle with Alzheimer's, at her daughter's home in Alliance. She was born on May 27, 1920 in Akron, Ohio, the second of 13 children to Sylvester and Garnet (Mills) Bordenkircher. She married Harry Wilson Snyder of Akron, Ohio on September 13, 1941 and was preceded in death by her husband, Harry Wilson Snyder in April, 2001; her parents Sylvester and Garnet Bordenkircher. She had resided in Alliance from 1951 until 1976 when she and her late husband, Harry, retired to Fort Myers, Florida and returned to Alliance in 2000. Martha volunteered at the Alliance Community Hospital and served terms as Secretary, Vice President and President of the Hospital Auxiliary Board of Directors, and was recognized in 1976 by the Ohio House of Representatives for hours worked and her service to the hospital. She was a Brownie, Girl Scout leader and volunteer in the library at Parkway Elementary School. She enjoyed golfing, dancing and playing cards with the "Telephone Wires". Her greatest contribution to Alliance was in supporting her Husband, Harry Snyder, in his political, civic interests and career as Commercial Manager for the Ohio Bell Telephone Company in Alliance.
