



## Mildred F. Cavanaugh

March 11, 1909 - July 30, 2002

Mildred F. Cavanaugh, age 93 of Alliance, died at Alliance Community Hospital on July 26, 2002. She was born March 11, 1909 in Leavittsville, Ohio, a daughter of William and Nora (Merriman) Saltzgiver. Mrs. Cavanaugh was a graduate of Dellroy High School and received her RN degree from Mercy Hospital School of Nursing. She also attended John Carroll University and Mount Union College.
