With great sadness, the friends of Nancy Kendall Stitt announce her passing on January 28, 2010 at the age of 85. Born to Homer and Eileen Kendall of Alliance, Ohio, Nancy arrived in New York to pursue a career in vocal music in the early 1950's. Shortly thereafter, she married the late Rev. Jesse Stitt, Minister of The Village Presbyterian Church. Throughout her career as an ensemble singer, Nancy performed with most of New York City's major concert organizations and was instrumental in the creation of the Village Light Opera Company serving as an early director. Nancy was an active soloist in many houses of worship and was director of music of the Woodstock Jesuit Community at St. Paul's Chapel, Columbia University, organizing the liturgical music for the annual ordinations of Jesuit priests at Fordham University. In addition to her performance career, Nancy was a faithful member of AGMA, serving many years as a member of its governing board. She was also a President of Church Women United. Her talent, dedication and joy in watching her beloved New York Mets will be sorely missed. Graveside services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, February 3, 2010 at Fairmount Memorial Park, with Pastor Jim McCurdy of First Presbyterian Church officiating.
