November 2, 1918 - June 18, 2013

Olive B. Johnson, 94, of Alliance, died on Tuesday, June 18, 2013, at 6:06 p.m. at Sterling House of Alliance. She was born on November 2, 1918 in Alliance, and lived in Alliance all of her life. She was a 1937 graduate of Alliance High School and a member of the First Presbyterian Church and their Women's Circle. She retired from Alliance Machine in 1953, where she was employed as Secretary to the Chief Engineer. Mrs. Johnson was a member of the Stark County Gem and Mineral Club, where she was past Hostess and co-editor of their monthly newsletter, the I.G.I.M. Knitting Group, and was a life member of the B.P.O. Elks #467Auxillary. She is survived by a daughter, Judith Johnson of New York, NY; a brother, Andy Bratu of Minerva; and several nieces and nephews. Preceding her in death was her husband, David B. Johnson in 2001, whom she married in 1949; a son, David M. Johnson; her parents, Andy and Anna (Costia) Bratu; and a sister, Ann Chisler.
