



Pauline Maxwell

January 16, 1918 - May 13, 2006

Rev. Pauline Maxwell, of Tempe, AZ, and formerly of Alliance, died on May 9, 2006 in Phoenix, AZ. Miss Maxwell was born in Akron, Ohio on January 16, 1918. She was educated at Spring Arbor College and at the Roberts Wesleyan College and had traveled world wide with special interest in young people. Rev. Maxwell served as pastor at the First Church of God in Alliance from 1974 until 1983. She then served at the Valley Community Church of God in Phoenix, AZ where she was senior pastor until 1996, then becoming Pastor Emeritus. After resigning her regular work, she filled in for ministers and held numerous conferences and camps. Miss Maxwell was also known as "Aunt Polly" through her "Bit of Plaid" radio program that ran five years on W.T.O.F. Canton. Survivors include a niece, Mrs. Harold McCutcheon of Uniontown; numerous great nieces and nephews; and her longtime friend, Joan Sheldon of Tempe, AZ, who cared for her since 1984. She was preceded in death by her parents, Rev. Robert and Nellie Maxwell, and her brother, Rev. Robert Maxwell. Funeral services will be held at the First Church of God on Saturday, May 13, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. with Rev. Larry Murphy officiating. Interment will follow at the Olive Cemetery in Caldwell, Ohio. There will be no calling hours. A memorial service will also be held at the Valley Community Church of God in Phoenix, AZ on Saturday, May 20, 2006. Funeral arrangements are being handled by the Walton-Schrader Funeral Home.
