Vernon F. Egli, 90, of Alliance, died on Monday, July 2, 2012, at 3:30 a.m. at Sterling House of Alliance. He was born on May 21, 1922 in Alliance, and lived in the Alliance area all of his life. He was a graduate of Alliance High School. A veteran of World War II, he served our country in the U. S. Army. Vernon was a farmer and bus driver for Alliance and West Branch School Districts for many years. After selling his farm, he worked at Homestead Meats as a truck driver and meat cutter.
